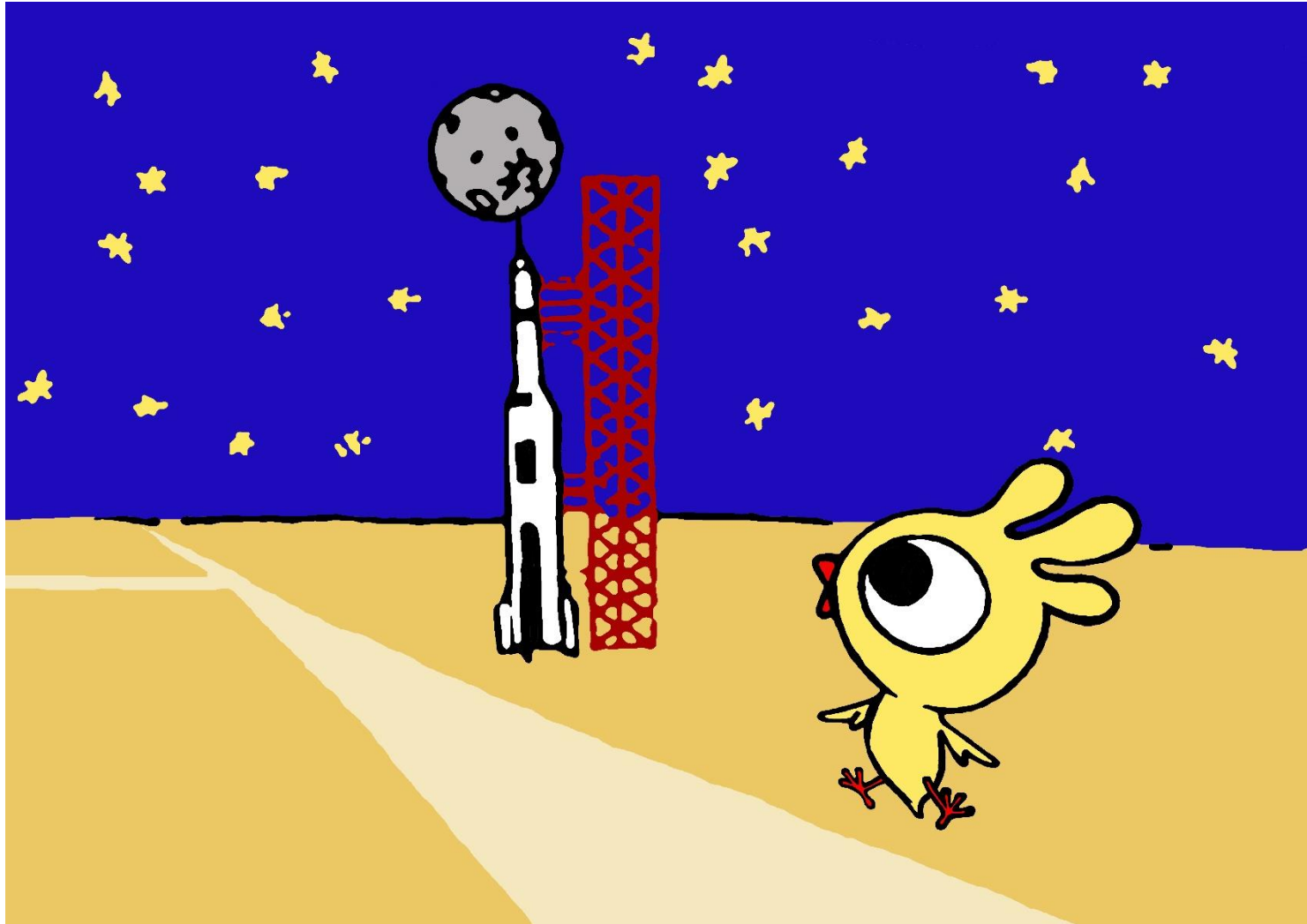
... A LITTLE CHICK WAS BORN.



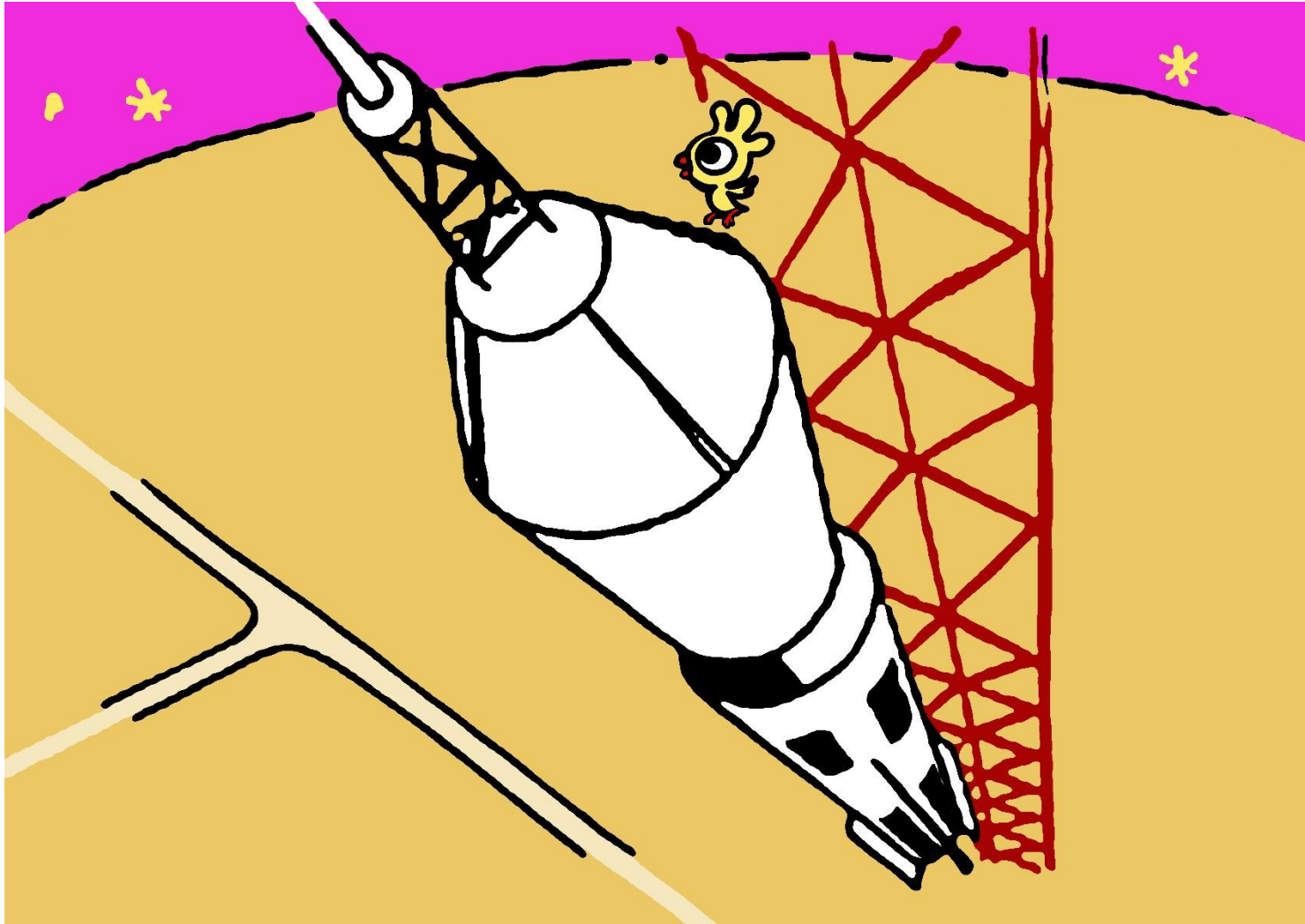
THE FIRST THING HE SAW WAS... THE MOON!



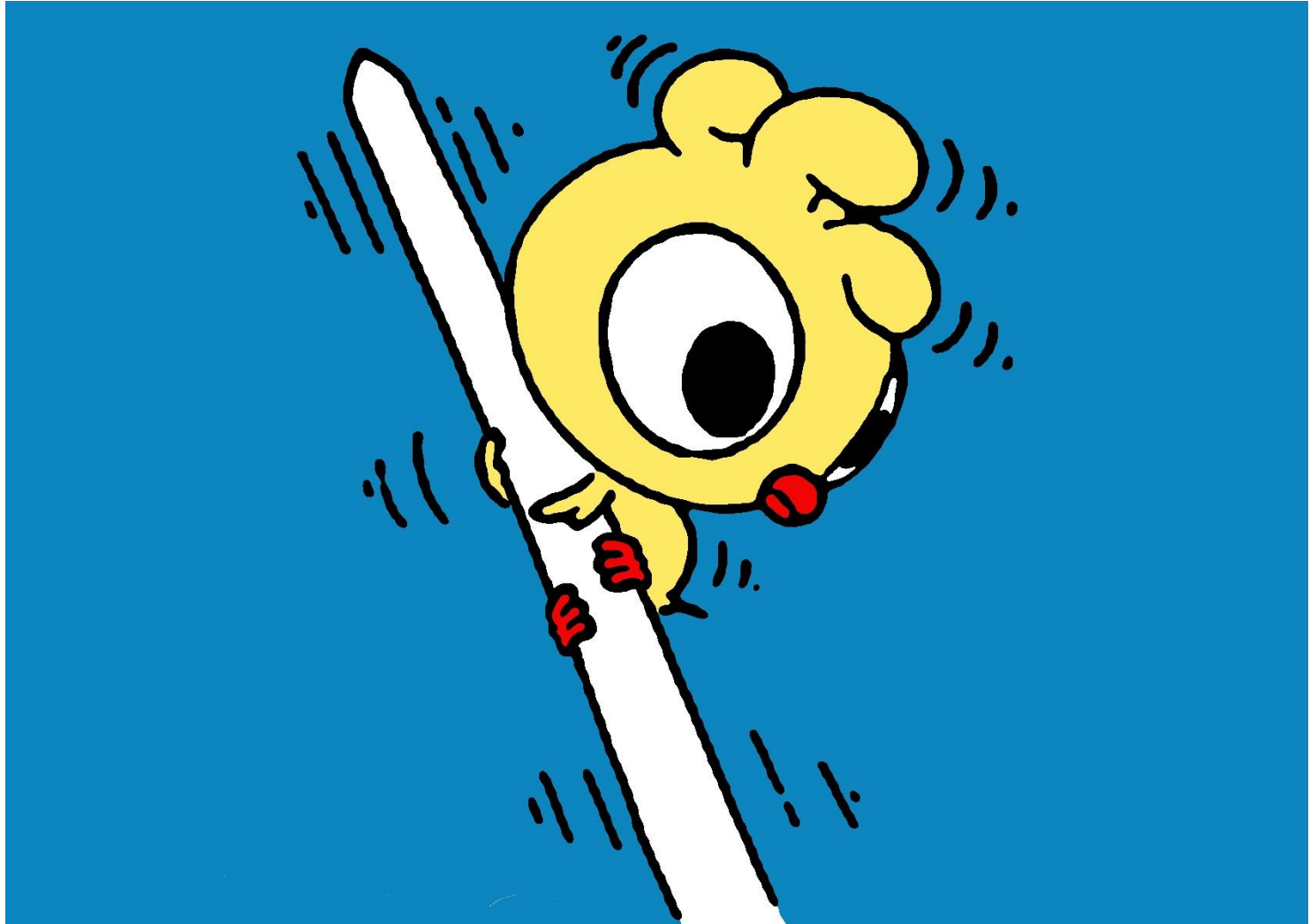
CHICK DREAMED OF GOING THERE...



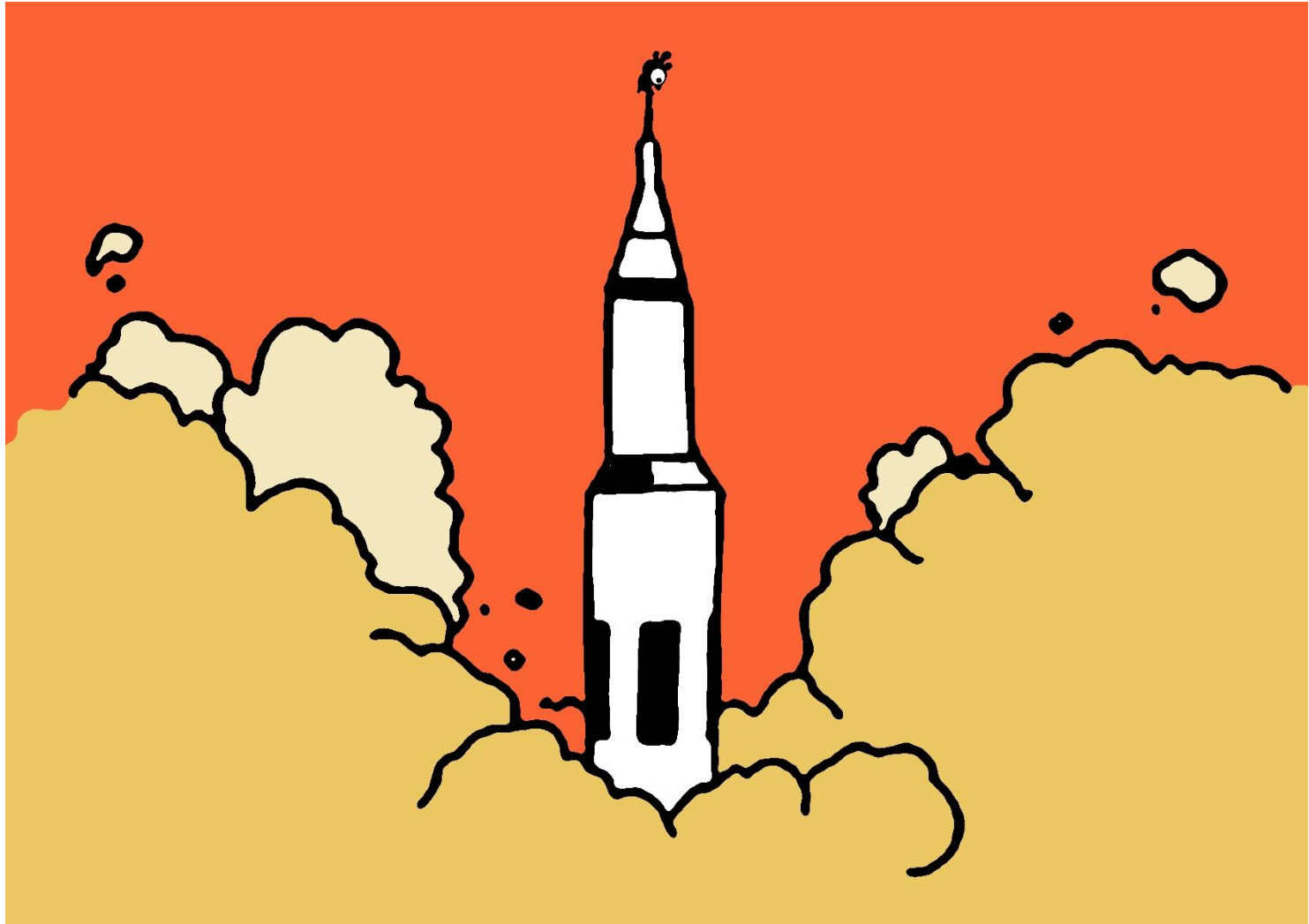
ONE DAY, HE SPOTTED A ROCKET TOUCHING THE MOON!



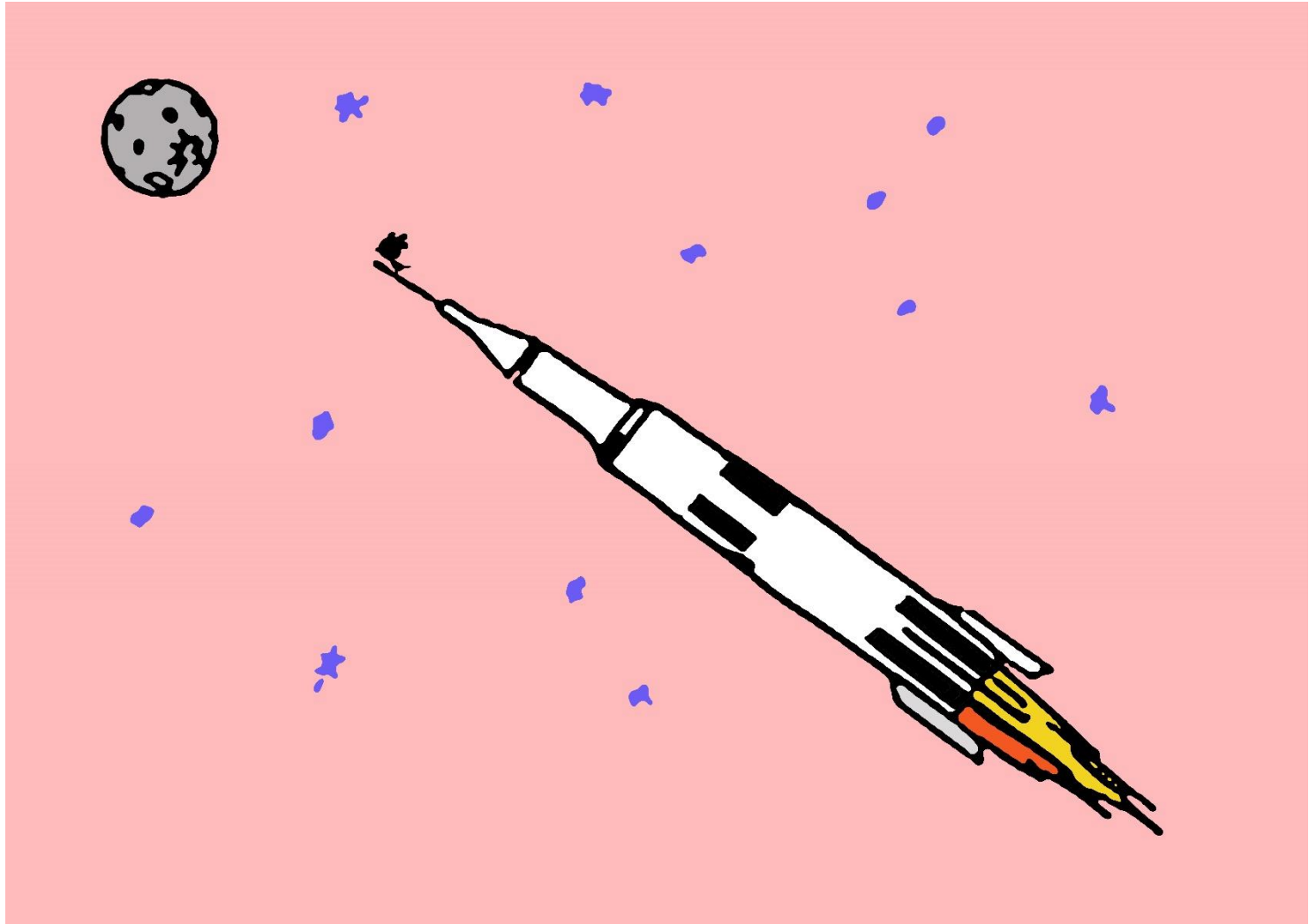
CHICK CLIMBED TO ITS TOP.

SOON, CHICK LIFTS OFF TO HIS DREAM.



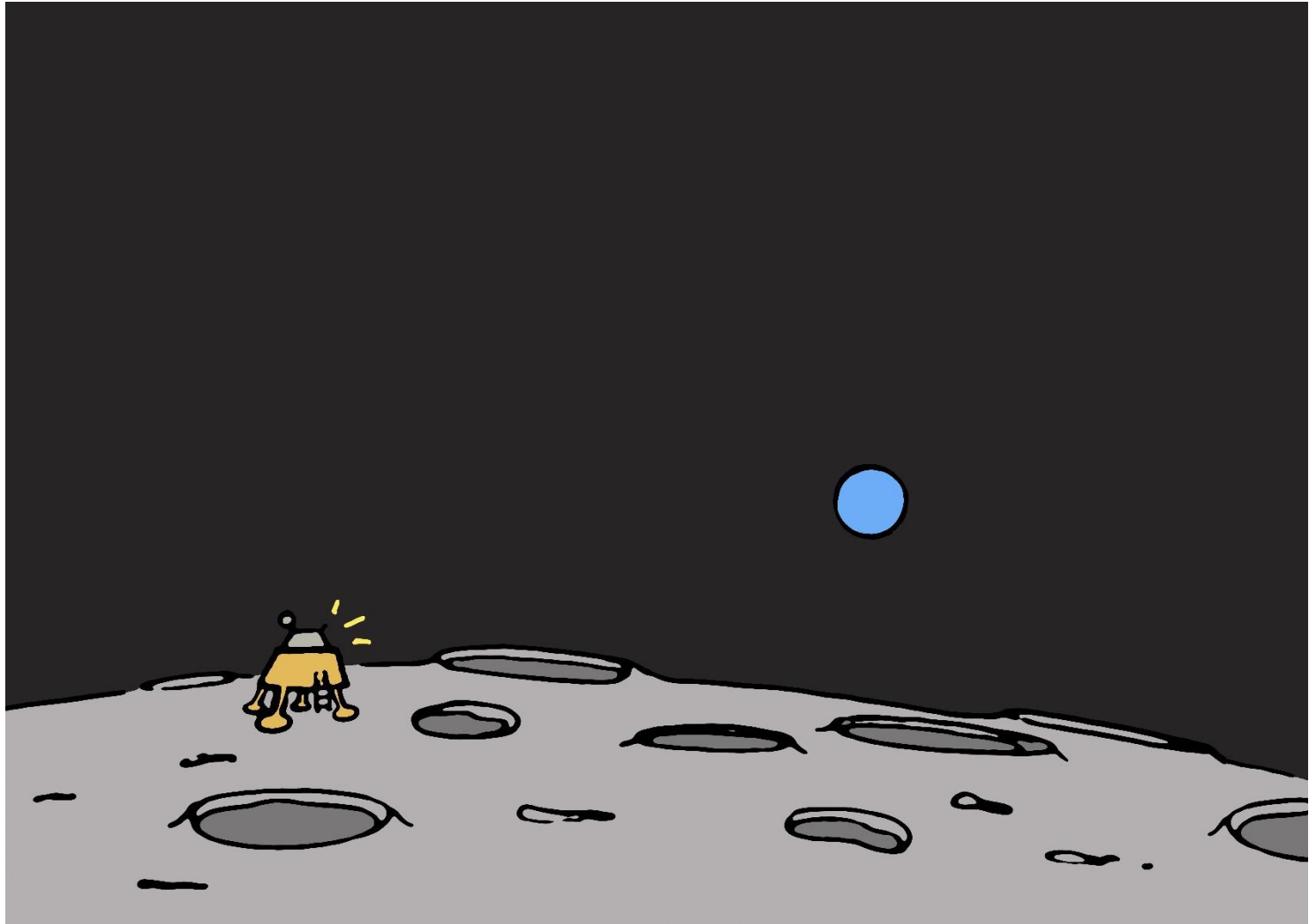
**AMONG THE STARS , THE SPACECRAFT LUNAPOLLO

CHICK, HAPPY, SURFS IN SPACE!



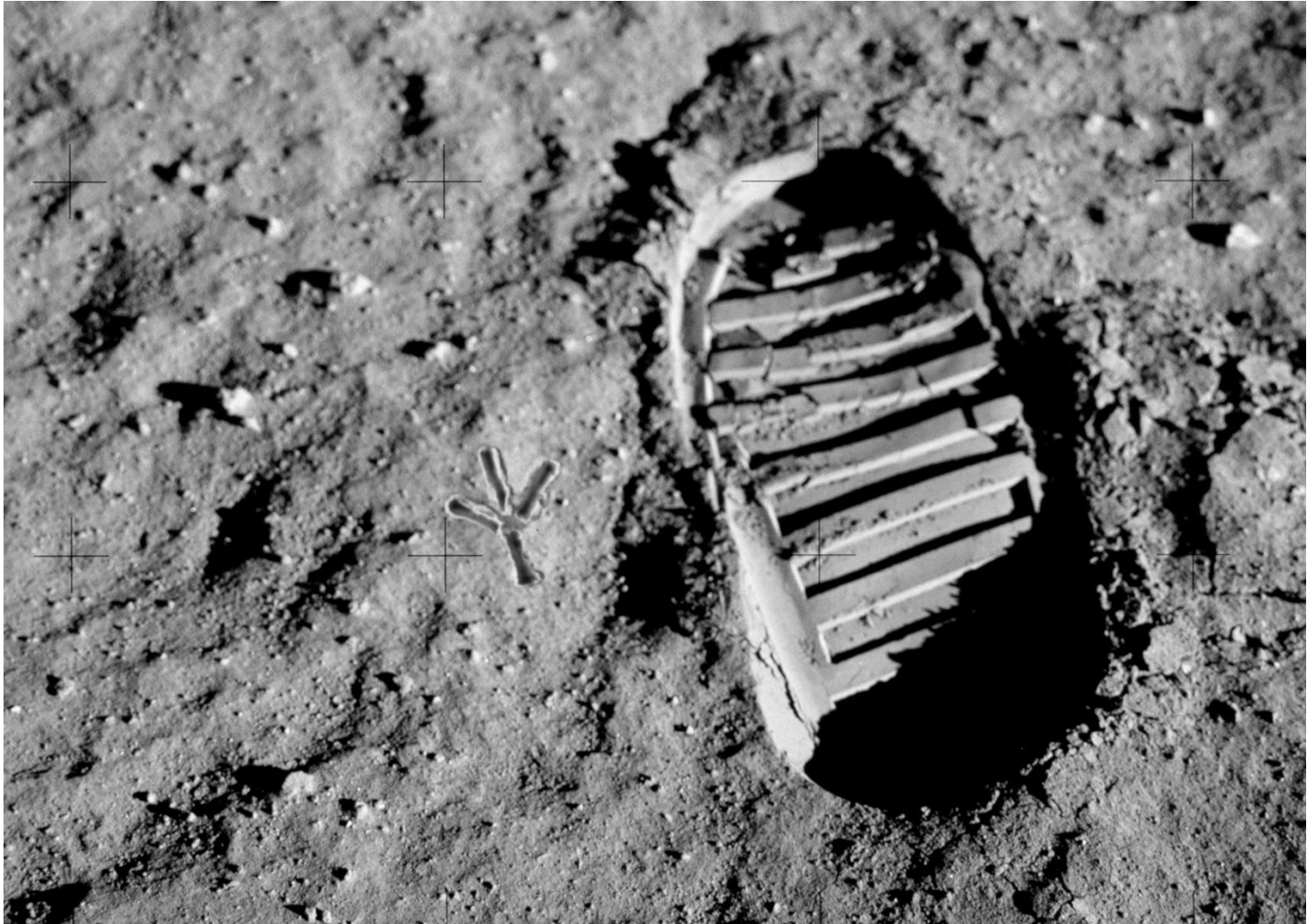
THE NEXT DAY LUNAPOLLO APPROACHES THE MOON.

“A SMALL STEP FOR ME, A GIANT LEAP FOR US ALL!”.

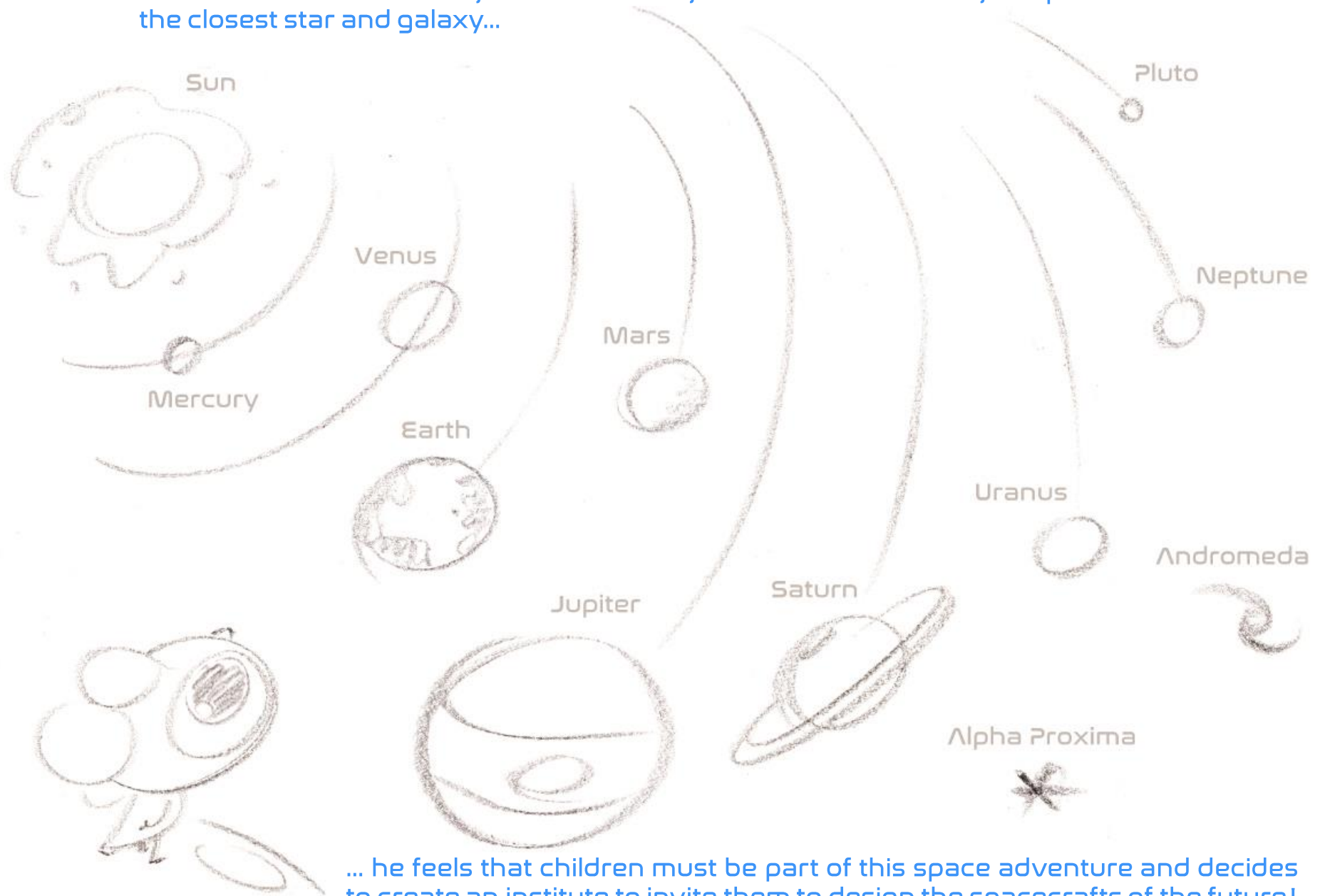


AND HISTORY RECORDS **CHICK** AND THE ASTRONAUT

... he feels that children must be part of this space adventure and decides to create an institute to invite them to design the spacecrafts of the future!



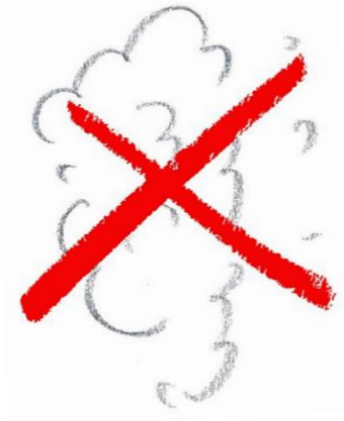
